FOCUS ST. LOUIS PRIVACY POLICY

Our Commitment to Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. Our ongoing commitment to the protection of your privacy is essential to maintaining the relationship of trust that exists between Focus St. Louis and all visitors to our website. This Privacy Policy is intended to help you understand Focus St. Louis' information security practices.

The Information We Collect

You may have directly accessed Focus St. Louis' website, the home page of which is located at <http://focus-stl.org/>. ("Website") or via link on a third party website. This Privacy Policy applies to all personally identifiable information you submit to Focus St. Louis through the Website. Please note that Focus St. Louis cannot be responsible for the information you submit to any third party websites, which may have their own posted policies regarding collection of information. We urge you to review the policies of any website through whom you may access our services.

Focus St. Louis actively collects personally identifiable information through the Website. ("Information") The Information collected includes information you give us and automatic information such as: Internet Protocol (IP) addresses used to connect your computer to the Internet; login; e-mail address; password; computer and connection information such as browser type and version, operating system, and platform information. Focus St. Louis reserves the right, at any time, to revise this Privacy Policy and / or change the extent of information it collects from you without notice. Any such revisions will be signified by changing the last updated date at the top of this webpage. Your continued use of the Website following the posting of the revisions to this Privacy Policy will mean your acceptance of the revisions.

Your access to the Website is hereby deemed acceptance of Focus St. Louis' practices described in this Policy Policy. All information shared by you with Focus St. Louis through the Website is subject to the provisions of this Privacy Policy.

Focus St. Louis does not intend to collect or maintain information from users actually known to be under the age of 13, and no part of Focus St. Louis's website is structured to attract anyone under the age of 13.

How We Use Information

Focus St. Louis uses the Information it collects about you to facilitate providing information and / or services to you by Focus St. Louis and / or Focus St. Louis authorized members. Such services may include, but are not limited to, weekly calender event emails, newsletters and event announcements. Focus St. Louis will not sell your

Information and except as described herein, Focus St. Louis will not distribute your information.

In addition, Focus St. Louis may use or share aggregate information about you in an effort to improve its services to you. This information shows user activity as a whole rather than on an individual basis and cannot be used to individually identify you.

Further, Focus St. Louis may release your Information to appropriate governmental authorities where release is required by law (for example, a subpoena) or by a regulation, or is requested by a government agency conducting investigations or proceedings. Focus St. Louis may also use your Information where it believes, in its sole discretion, that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone (including yourself) who may have breached Focus St. Louis' Terms of Use Agreement or who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) Focus St. Louis' rights or property, other Focus St. Louis' users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities.

Third-party Service Providers

Occasionally, Focus St. Louis hires third-party service providers to help it provide or improve the services it offers to you. Sometimes it is necessary for these providers to have access to the Information Focus St. Louis collects about you. In those cases, Focus St. Louis takes reasonable steps to ensure that these providers do not use or otherwise disclose any Information except for the purpose of fulfilling their service obligations to Focus St. Louis.

Use of Cookies

Focus St. Louis, collects non-identifiable and personal information through the use of various technologies, including 'cookies.' You can set your browser to be notified before a cookie is received, and thereby have an opportunity to decide whether to accept cookies. If you decide to refuse cookies, you may not be able to view and / or access the Website and /or other third party websites as intended.

Accessing Another Web Site Through the Focus St. Louis Website

The Website contains links to other websites. Focus St. Louis is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such other websites.

How You Can Delete or Correct Your Information

You have the right at any time to cease permitting your Information to be collected, used or disclosed by Focus St. Louis, or to seek changes thereto, by contacting Focus St. Louis via e-mail [fslstl@focus-stl.org], or certified postal mail [*FOCUS ST. LOUIS, 815 Olive Street, St. Louis, MO 63101*]. After processing such correspondence, Focus St. Louis will delete or modify, as applicable, your Information.

Our Commitment to Data Security

Focus St. Louis uses industry standard encryption technologies when transferring and receiving your Information, and maintains industry standard security measures in its physical facility to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of your Information collected by Focus St. Louis. However, since internet transmissions cannot be made absolutely secure, Focus St. Louis shall not be liable for unauthorized disclosure of personal information due to no fault of Focus St. Louis including, but not limited to, errors in transmission and unauthorized acts of third parties.

If you have created a registered account on the Website and have secured it with a password, you must take care not to divulge your password to anyone. Focus St. Louis will never ask you for your password in an unsolicited phone call or e-mail. You are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your passwords and any account information saved or transmitted outside of Focus St. Louis' systems.

In the unlikely event that Focus St. Louis undergoes a sale or transfer of all or substantially all of its assets, the acquiring entity will be subject to this privacy policy in its use of your Information. In addition, in the further unlikely event that Focus St. Louis is adjudicated bankrupt or insolvent (a) there will be no further use or disclosure of your Information by Focus St. Louis and (b) your Information will be destroyed. In addition, there will be no use or disclosure of your Information by any entity that acquires assets of Focus St. Louis pursuant to such bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings.
